INFORMATION SHEET

PURPOSE OF THE CLIFFORD FOUNDATION

The purpose of the foundation is to provide academic scholarships for selected students for postsecondary educational cost at Texas supported public colleges, universities, or technical schools. The Clifford Foundation selects qualified applicants who might not be able to attend a college, university or technical college on a full-time basis without this scholarship. **The Clifford Foundation has expanded its mission in recent years and now offers three types of scholarships.**

❖ *CLIFFORD FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP FOR GRADUATING HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS*

WHO MAY APPLY?

Any graduating senior of a Navarro County, Texas public high school who has been accepted to attend a Texas state supported public college, university or technical college and who has completed the Navarro County College Achievement Program (CAP), may apply. It is required that each applicant have a minimum total SAT score of 1000 or an ACT minimum composite score of 21.

WHAT DOES THE SCHOLARSHIP PAY FOR?

The scholarship will be applied towards your tuition, required fees, recommended course textbooks or eBook and room and board not paid for by other financial aid resources. The textbook and eBook allowance shall not exceed \$1,000 per semester without prior approval from the Clifford Foundation. The room and board allowance per semester will not exceed \$3,750.00 per semester.

WHEN ARE THE APPLICATIONS DUE?

Check with the Navarro County College Achievement Program (CAP) for current deadlines.

❖ *CLIFFORD FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP STUDENTS WITH AT LEAST 60 COLLEGE HOURS*

WHO MAY APPLY?

Any student who (1) has completed the Navarro County College Achievement Program (CAP), (2) anticipates completing 60 hours of college credit hours at the end of the current semester within three years with an overall GPA of least a 2.5, (3) presents a degree plan approved by CAP that projects the completion of an undergraduate degree or certification in no more than five semesters, (4) has been admitted to a public college, university or technical college in Texas, and (5) the student has consulted with a CAP advisor prior to the beginning of each semester after high school. Application can be made when the applicant has successfully completed 48 hours.

WHAT DOES THE SCHOLARSHIP PAY FOR?

The scholarship will be applied towards your tuition, required fees, recommended course textbooks or eBook and room and board not paid for by other financial aid resources. The textbook and eBook allowance shall not exceed \$1,000 per semester without prior approval from the Clifford Foundation. The room and board allowance per semester will not exceed \$3,750.00 per semester. The scholarship may only be used at a Texas supported public college, university, or technical college, accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools, and approved by the Clifford Foundation.

WHAT IS THE TERM OF THE SCHOLARSHIP?

The Clifford Foundation scholarships are one-semester scholarships, which can be renewed up to a total of five consecutive semesters. The scholarship will be reviewed each semester to verify that the recipient has fulfilled the requirements of the scholarship.

❖ ***CLIFFORD FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP FOR GRADUATE SCHOOL ASSISTANCE***

WHO MAY APPLY?

Any student who (1) has completed the Navarro County CAP Program within the last two years; (2) has been awarded a bachelor's degree; (3) has been admitted to a graduate, medical, veterinary, dental or law school at a public college or university in Texas.

WHAT DOES THE SCHOLARSHIP PAY FOR?

The scholarship will be applied towards your tuition, required fees and recommended course textbooks or eBook not paid for by other financial aid resources.

WHAT IS THE TERM OF THE SCHOLARSHIP?

The Clifford Foundation scholarships are one-semester scholarships, which can be renewed up to a total of four consecutive semesters. The scholarship will be reviewed each semester to verify that the recipient has fulfilled the requirements of the scholarship.

WHEN CAN I APPLY?

Applicants may apply during their senior year of college, but no later than one year after obtaining their bachelor's degree. Incomplete applications will not be considered. There will be no exceptions.
